



My name is Alicia Davis, I am a proud 7th generation Texan and lifetime resident of Jasper County. This past summer on June 7th, I announced my candidacy for HD 21 State Representative to unseat Dade Phelan. Knowing full well I'd be the underdog in this race, I had the courage to make the decision to step up and run for the first time because someone had to do something. Texans who do not reside in our district or those simply seeking vengeance or to climb a political ladder don't quite understand that this is not just about "getting rid" of Dade Phelan or a speakership. Covid shutdowns forced me into retirement, so I have had a considerable amount of time on my hands to be a fierce, passionate advocate and defender for common everyday people and our most fundamental rights and freedoms. I have shown up, stood up, spoken up and walked the walk, not just talked the talk when nobody else would. You won't see me give myself a pat on the

I chose to stand up to tyranny for the people and fought back against the fraud, corruption and favoritism that property owners are being forced to pay for and I have a target on my back for doing so. This is why you will not find many public officials or those who benefit from the property tax scheme rooting for me. However, you will find a hell of a lot of thankful and grateful struggling property owners who I can guarantee will show up to show their gratitude come March 5th. You won't find this

kind of campaign statistics on any poll created by the mainstream media, establishment or anyone else. I'm asking for y'all to send me to Austin to continue being the voice and warrior for the real people that we deserve and because out of the three of us, I have been the ONLY one that has actually gone to war for us when I wasn't being paid to or didn't even have to.
